

STUDENTS EXCITED.

A NEGRO ASSAULTS A CADET AT BLACKSBURG.

He is Run Down and Captured—On His Way to Jail He Fires on One of His Guards and Escapes.

BLACKSBURG, VA., April 21.—(Special.)—While the corps of cadets were at supper yesterday evening, in the mess-hall, a negro employee grossly insulted one of their number. This was, of course, immediately resented, especially as the negro used very foul language. Blows were passed, and both the student and the negro, John Ekeridge by name, were wounded about the head by the missiles thrown. Upon several other students coming up, the negro attempted to escape by jumping out of a rear window and taking to his heels. A number of the students pursued him, and a very lively and exciting chase followed. The negro—a strong, muscular, burly fellow—was finally overhauled about a mile out of town, and surrendered. He was brought back to the college grounds, and a warrant was sworn out for his arrest on the charge of assault and battery. Justice Floyd O'By, before whom the case was tried, after hearing all the evidence pro and con, committed the negro to jail for sixty days, and imposed, in addition, a fine of \$50.

GREAT EXCITEMENT.

Great excitement prevailed for a time among the students over the outrage thus put upon one of their number. Owing to the cool counsels of President McBride and Commandant Shanks, this quickly subsided, however, and at the time of the trial all was as quiet as if no trouble had occurred. The constable, G. W. Fleet, with a guard, then undertook to convey the prisoner to the jail at Blacksburg. Though it was 6 o'clock this morning, the guard was asked to stop at his house and wash himself. This was granted, and the guard surrounded the house. After coming out, the negro walked a few steps, and then suddenly leaping to the ground, he fired, one of the guard, quickly followed.

FIRED ON THE GUARD.

The negro suddenly wheeled, and, with a pistol, fired almost into Mr. Lee's face. Fortunately, however, he wheeled a little too far around to the left, and the ball passed over Lee's head. The negro then broke into a run for life, and, though fired at repeatedly, made good his escape. His assault in the mess-hall was particularly dastardly and outrageous, since the student whom he overhauled, with a few exceptions, and then assaulted, is a remarkably quiet, inoffensive, and studious boy. It was stated this morning that the negro was a fugitive from justice, having already killed a man in one of the States. His offense in this case has been severely aggravated by attempt to kill his guard and resistance to all the officers of the law. It is probable that a reward will yet be brought to justice. The indignation among the students is still very great, and justly so.

TAZEWELL.

Death of a Popular Lady—Stricken With Paralysis.

TAZEWELL, VA., April 21.—(Special.)—The death of Mrs. Mollie May, wife of S. D. May, one of our most prominent lawyers, which occurred Sunday evening, has cast a gloom over the community. In the bloom of womanhood—25 years of age—surrounded by a happy family, with prospects bright for a future, she was suddenly called away, and a feeling of desolation pervades the once happy and joyous home. The funeral services took place from the Presbyterian church at 10 o'clock yesterday evening, and the large concourse which attended the burial attests the high esteem in which this Christian wife and mother was held. The Circuit Court and bar adjourned out of respect to her husband, and attended the funeral. Dr. R. W. Witten, one of the most prominent citizens and physicians in the county, had a partial stroke of paralysis a few days since, but has to some extent rallied.

THE WEEKLY CROP BULLETIN.

Warm, Growing Weather Has Prevailed—Rain Badly Needed.

The following is the general weekly report of Mr. Edward A. Evans, local forecast official and assistant director in charge of the Virginia branch of the Weather Bureau: Warm, growing weather has prevailed generally over the State during the past week, and all vegetation has responded rapidly under its influence. Grass is growing and making fine grazing for stock; early-planted vegetables and truck are putting out in a vigorous manner. Farm work has progressed satisfactorily, and most of the corn has been planted. Peaches, plums, and cherries are in full bloom in the eastern portion of the State, and apples and pears are coming in. Late frosts did not seriously injure the peach blossoms. There is some complaint of light blossoming of apples in sections of the Tidewater and Great Valley sections. Garden crops improving. The condition of winter wheat has advanced materially since last week. While it is generally thought that the fall amount seeded last fall will not come up, that which is showing has improved with the late rains, and is looking better than some gentle showers are now needed. Tobacco plants are flourishing, potatoes are being planted, and spring seeding is doing well. All would, however, be benefited by moderate showers.

TIDEWATER VIRGINIA.

Last fall's seeding is needing rain now. Spring seeding looking well. Fruit-blossoms plentiful except apples, which are light. The ground is getting hard. Grass is putting out rapidly, and forest trees are budding. Winter crops have improved, and are looking better than they were being pushed. Potato beds are reported somewhat backward in Accomac county. Forest fires are reported in the vicinity of Spotsylvania, Surry county.

MIDDLE VIRGINIA.

In some portions of this section considerable corn has been planted since the date of the last report, and in others, where the weather has been more backward, farmers are breaking the ground for corn. Fruit-blossoms are plentiful, and in good condition, except early peaches, which are somewhat backward. Tobacco plants are showing a good and vigorous growth, except in Henry county, and part of Charlotte county, where they are small. Some re-planting of tobacco has been done. Winter wheat is reported as improving. Winter crops are being damaged, but spring crops are up to their usual condition. Clover is growing rapidly. Rain would be of benefit.

THE GREAT VALLEY.

The reports of correspondents indicate that winter wheat has improved very much under the influence of the warm weather, and is getting a good start. Farmers are well up with their work. Plowing is general and garden-making is progressing. Some fruit-trees are in bloom. Preparations are being made for corn-planting. Some has been planted in Botetourt county. Spring crops are nearly all sown. Grasses are growing fast in most localities. Rain is now needed.
