Wants the New Manual of Arms—Demands for Tents—Other Matters. The Adjutant-General of Virginia, General Charles J. Anderson, is in receipt of a communication from Captain T. C. Scroggs, commandant of the Lynchburg Home Guards, which is Company E, Third Virginia Regiment, requesting the Adjutant-General to render such aid as he can in the adoption of the new manual of arms of the United States army, which is now used in a satisfactory manner at the Virginia Military Institute and at West Point.

The Adjutant-General, in his reply, sets forth that it has been the intention of his department all the time to follow the United States regulations in every particular as far as possible. In this case his office has been waiting for the issuing of the War Department of the new United States Infantry regulations, which, however, have not yet been adopted.
