THE BELT LINE THAT IS TO GIR- DLE THEM.

Work of Construction to Be Pushed.

Marriage of a Minister-School Board and Flags—Money for Yellow-Fever Sufferers.

NORFOLK, VA., November 2.—(Special)—Work on the new Belt-Line railway, which is to girdle Norfolk, Portsmouth, and Berkeley, and which will do away with much barking in the harbor, is being rapidly pushed.

The route has been surveyed, and the actual work of construction is under way.

Its name will be the Southeastern and Atlantic, and Mr. A. J. Cassatt will be the president.

Rev. L. R. Wright, pastor of Grace Baptist church, of this city, was wed to-day to Miss Agnes Morson, niece of Mr. Thomas Morson of Norfolk.

The School Board of this city will recommend the display of both the National and State flags on public schools, instead of the State flag alone.

At a meeting of the Howard Association, of this city, to-day, it was decided to send \$500 to the "Cant-Get-Away Club," of Mobile, Ala., and \$500 to the Mayor of Biloxi, Miss., these amounts to be used in relieving the distress brought on these places by yellow-fever.

The treasurer of the association will forward the drafts immediately.

RAILROAD-RATES WAR.

The Chesapeake and Ohio and Norfolk and Western.

NORFOLK, VA., November 2.—(Special)—The Chesapeake and Ohio and the Norfolk and Western railroads have locked horns in a battle royal for the local traffic between Richmond and Norfolk.

The Norfolk and Western led off to-day with a slash of 20 per cent. on straight and 25 per cent. on round-trip fares.

This reduces the rate to \$2 straight and \$3.50 round-trip, as against \$2.50 and \$3.50.

The Chesapeake and Ohio people here heard of the proposed action of their rival in time to meet the rate as soon as it went into effect.

As the slash only affects local tariffs, the usual ten-day notice to the Interstate Commerce Commission is unnecessary.

It is not thought that a further cut will be made by either line.

THE COCKADE CITY.

PETERSBURG, VA., November 2.—(Special)—It is understood that the Petersburg Savings and Insurance Company has purchased the building and site at the southwest corner of Tabb and Sycamore streets, now occupied by the Eigenbrunn Clothing Company, one of the best business sites in the city.

THE ALLEGED MASONIC IMPOSTOR.

It is charged that the man, Hugh C. Hunter alias Simmons, now in jail here in default of payment of a fine imposed for drunkenness, has, on representations made by a fellow inmate, the Methodist Episcopal church, one of the members of the order in Richmond, Portsmouth, and Petersburg.

The paper he carries bears the name of Hugh C. Hunter, while he has confessed that his name is Simmons.

The paper purports to have been issued by the May's Lodge, No. 1, J. Masonic Lodge, but on examination, it is shown that the lodge seal and letter heading are pasted on the paper, and the lodge denies all knowledge of Hunter or Simmons.

Charges of obtaining money under false pretences, were therefore preferred against Simmons, as the case will probably be heard on Thursday morning.
