MUST GIVE IN NAMES.

LAW REQUIRING COMPANIES TO REPORT OFFICERS & DIRECTORS. THE STATUTE BEING CRITICISED.

Some Corporations Have Not Complied With the Act and Steps May Be Made to Enforce It—The Delinquent Tax.

Many strong protests have been registered in the Hustings Court of late by representatives of the corporations, which fell heirs to a rather irksome law at the hands of the last General Assembly.

The act, which constitutes Chapter No. 817, bears the following title: "An act to require all companies, other than those incorporated for works of internal improvement, incorporated under the general incorporation law of this Commonwealth, to file annually a list of their officers and directors, and in cases when the officers and directors are not residents of the county or corporation in which the principal office of the company is located, to appoint resident attorneys or agents, and to prohibit them from exercising their charter privileges until the requirements of this act shall have been complied with."

The act was approved March 24 of this year. It provides that every incorporated company, other than those incorporated for works of internal improvement, shall, within thirty days after each annual meeting, certify to the Clerk of the county or corporation court where its principal office is located a list of the officers and directors of such company elected at annual meetings, and it shall be the duty of the Clerk of such county or corporation court to keep a file of such certificates, which shall be open to public inspection.

A HEAVY PENALTY. The penalty prescribed for non-compliance with this law is as follows: "Any such company failing, after the passage of this act, to comply with its provisions, shall be prohibited from exercising any rights whatever under its charter of incorporation, until the provisions of this act have been complied with; but this provision shall not operate to prevent the enforcement of any contract against such company made by it during the period of such default."

LAND-TAX SYNDICATES RETIRE. The syndicates who came here several weeks ago to operate under the new delinquent tax law have retired from the field. That their absence is only temporary, however, is shown by a communication received by Mr. Leroy Brown a day or so ago, asking him not to press his case against the syndicates.
