THE TRADES PARADE.

LINE OF MARCH ADOPTED FOR THE GRAND PAGEANT. AIDS TO THE CHIEF MARSHAL.

They Met Last Evening and Received Instructions--General Lee is Coming--The President and Admiral Dewey Are Expected.

The trades parade to be held in this city the 31st instant incidental to the launching of the Shubrick will be one of the grandest pageants which have passed over the streets of Richmond in many years.

This is now assured, and the committee from the Civic Carnival Association having the arrangements for this feature of the launching celebration in charge are busy mapping out their plans and arranging to have the display presented in its most attractive form.

The committee met last night with the aids to the chief marshal, and instructed them as to what would be expected of them, and then held an extended session, devoting several hours to details.
