NEW YORK, November 3.—Messrs. R. G. Dun & Co.'s Weekly Review of Trade will say to-morrow: "The British disasters in South Africa have brought to view something besides the steady self-reliance of the British people to wit, that they hold not many American securities to be dislodged in any time of alarm, but are inclined to take more when money looks for safe investment."

WOOL AND COTTON. The enormous sales of wool at Boston, 2,157,500 pounds, as reported, making 25,000,000 at the three chief markets this week, are extremely important. That they are not for consumption, as the trade is naturally tempted to believe, may be true, and yet actual purchases by the mills of half that quantity would imply extraordinary encouragement for the demand for woolen goods.

IRON AND STEEL. Prices of pig-iron for early deliveries are still advancing, but as a great part of the demand has protected itself by contracts running far into the next year, including purchases of 30,000 tons of Bessemer this week at \$23.50, and as billets are quoted at \$23.75 for spot, but \$3 for next year, the market can be interpreted in several ways. Anthracite pig is also quoted at \$23.75 for early delivery, but finished products have advanced during the past week, except in refined bars, which the Eastern Association has put up \$1 per ton. More weakness appears in some lines, of which the works have not contracts running far ahead. But it is estimated that 1,000 tons of rails—80 per cent of the entire capacity—has been sold for next year.
