C. & O. MAN PROMOTED MASTER-MECHANIC LLOYD GOES TO THE LACKAWANNA. BIDS FOR THE NEW UNION DEPOT.

Mr. Thomas S. Lloyd, who has been master mechanic of the Chesapeake and Ohio railway for about ten years, has resigned to accept the position of superintendent of motive power of the Delaware, Lackawanna and Western railroad at a salary of \$8,000 a year.

Mr. Lloyd's headquarters will be at Beranton, Pa. He will leave Richmond in a short time to enter upon his new duties. They will be numerous enough.

Mr. Lloyd was born in Pittsburg in 1852, and from 1855 to 1883 acquired his trade in the locomotive works in that town. In 1883 he went as a journeyman to Erie, Pa.

Mr. Lloyd has made a reputation in his work probably second to that of no man in the country. Mr. Lloyd is a married man with several children. He recently lost two daughters by death.
