ARE ANXIOUS NOW. FOREIGN BOARD ALARMED ABOUT REV. AND MRS. LOWE. His Church Wants Him for Another Year-Takes Till Next Sunday to Decide-Dr. Quarles at Leigh-Street-Personal Mention.

The most intense interest is felt by Richmond people in the fate of the Americans in China, and particularly is this true of the American missionaries there.

The Southern Baptists have the central office of their Foreign Mission Board here. Dr. B. J. Williamson is the secretary, but has for some days been absent from the city.

Dr. E. E. Bomar is the assistant secretary, and yesterday evening he made the following statement of more than ordinary interest to a Dispatch writer: "The Foreign Mission Board has, as yet, no news by cable or letter from its missionaries in China concerning the situation there, except press dispatches, assuring us of the safety of all the missionaries in Northern China, except Rev. Mr. Lowe and wife, of Ping-tu."

It is hoped that the omission of his name in the dispatches was simply a clerical error, but as no news has come to the board concerning them, and as they were farthest inland from Chefoo, there is beginning to arise a feeling of anxiety as to their safety.
