IN STRUCTURE OF THE UNIVERSE. The Gifted Lecturer and Critic Makes a Plea for the Use of Woman's Influence in Making the World More Beautiful. The auditorium of the Woman's Club was crowded yesterday afternoon at 4:20 o'clock when Dr. Hamilton W. Mable gave an inspiring talk on "Beauty as a Public Necessity."
