CHARGED WITH FRAUD

SENSATIONAL SUIT AGAINST THE NORFOLK COUNTY SUPERVISORS.

BAD COMBINATION ALLEGED.

Bill Declares They Owe the County Money—Strikers Enjoyed from Interfering With Street-Car-Lumber Trust Scheme Abandoned

NORFOLK, VA., March 26.—(Special.)—The Board of Supervisors of Norfolk County are the defendants in a highly sensational action brought against them by some of the most prominent citizens of the county—all members of the straight-out faction of the Democracy.

They recently tried to have the supervisors tried for malfeasance. It is now sought to recover from the defendants such moneys as they may have drawn in excess of the legal allowance of \$30 each per annum.

The bill sets forth that for eleven years past the supervisors have systematically and continuously violated the law relative to their compensation, and that they have been illegally and fraudulently paying out to themselves compensation greatly in excess of that allowed by law.

CHARGES A CORRUPT COMBINATION. The bill charges that the payments so made, except those to B. O. Fentress, were the result of an illegal, fraudulent, and corrupt combination upon the part of the supervisors to divert to themselves, in their individual capacities, money belonging to the county.

It charges that these amounts, which should be refunded to the county with interest, were paid to every member of the board during the seven years, and that the aggregate amount of \$12,700, which, it is claimed, was illegally diverted, was distributed in amounts of from \$25 to D. M. Harding, to \$3,000 to John A. Codd.

W. S. Johnson is said, in the bill, to have received \$2,500; E. R. Nimmo, \$2,600, and other amounts of \$500 and less.

It is claimed that the recovery of the amounts alleged to have been fraudulently obtained would materially lessen taxation.
