WILL NOT SHUT DOWN.

Re-Transfer of Fifty Operatives

Back to Old from New Factory

Started Rumor.

The transfer of the large force of operatives from the old factory of the American Cigar Company, in the old Kinney factory building, to the new and splendidly equipped plant of the cigar company on Cary street, which had been reported to have what delayed in consequence of orders from New York. It was reported yesterday that the cigar factory contemplated a shut down, which was variously stated at two weeks to three months. The Dispatch in its editorial has already denied and set at rest all such rumors. The big cigar factory of the American Cigar Company will not shut down, nor will it diminish its force.

It is true, however, that the transfer of operatives from the old factory to the new has been delayed somewhat, but not a single employee will be displaced thereby. The gradual transfer of operatives from the old factory to the new had been begun, and about fifty were at work in the new factory, when orders were received from New York Thursday to discontinue until further orders, and to return those operatives in the new factory to the old. This has been done. There were only forty or fifty of these, and they have been put at work again in the old factory. It is the purpose of the company to transfer all the operatives in the Whitlock branch to the splendid new factory, and thereafter to utilize the old Kinney factory, now occupied jointly as a cheroot factory and as a stemmer of the American Tobacco Company, exclusively as a stemmer. The gradual removal of operatives to the machines in the new factory had begun, as stated, when this order was received, but only a few had been transferred, and all those were immediately returned to the old plant. The delay is believed to be due to some action in connection with the choice of machines.

The new factory is equipped with 400 machines including the International Machine Company. Each of these machines has a maximum capacity of about 100 cigars per day, a maximum daily output for the entire factory, when in full operation, of about 1,500,000 cigars. Each operative is required for each machine, which is used in the making of the wrappers on. The filler or bunch is made and shaped by hand, and many of these bunch-makers are employed in addition to the operators of machines.

The American Cigar Company has received from the city permission to erect the large water tank which it proposes to locate in the alley north of the factory and which will be filled from the Gock by means of a powerful pump. The pipe and pumping apparatus will be put in the wrappers on. When this is completed the factory will not only have fire protection, but will be able to render valuable service to the city in cases of fire in the vicinity.
