

Mr. Nelan Corresponds with Pennypacker. (By Associated Press.) PHILADELPHIA, Pa., May 18.—In answer to the letter of May 15th from American, cartoonist of the North American, asking a retraction of the epithet, "Outcast," used by Governor Pennypacker in his reasons for signing the Grady-Salus Bill, the Governor has replied as follows:

"Sir, Your letter addressed to me has just been received. You are entirely correct in saying that your personality has never come under my observation, and I may add that I am entirely unconscious of ever having made, in any way, any reference to you."

"The state of the case as now presented by your letter of disclaimer is this: I drew a cartoon, signed with my name. You saw it and studied it. You said the man who drew it was a 'braided outcast.' You now say you are entirely unconscious of having referred to me by this imputation. Whether this holds together as a logical and veracious syllogism, the public will have to determine. I am not going to quibble over the matter, but shall give you the benefit of every technicality and of all presuppositions in favor of the candor and truthfulness of your statement. I shall not endeavor to hold you for your negligence merely under the provisions of the new law, the percentage of which is generally imputed to you."
