
"This association (the Jefferson Davis Monument Association) withdraws all its members from the thirteen columns in the columnade. They are not named and do not represent any particular State...

As already seen, the defendant in error was constantly and persistently in default in the payment of his premiums. He had relied on the agents to keep his property insured and keep up his premiums, and they advanced money for him on that account until the running insurance account between the assured and the balance in their favor of \$110.65, which he refused to pay and owed when the policies were canceled.
