NEW YORK, July 29.—Stocks reacted again today, but the market became much quieter. Dealings were decidedly smaller and fluctuations much narrower, marking the declining oscillation due to an approach to a stationary condition after the more violent disturbance of the earlier part of the week. The action of the market to-day suggested less a recurrence of the anxiety over the factors which broke prices on Wednesday than an undoing of some over hasty commitments made yesterday in the attack upon the market.
