SNYDER DIES TO SAVE SMALL BOY

Millionaire Boddler, Under Indictment in St. Louis, Killed in Own Automobile.

HAND OF FATE UPON THEM

Death Seems Determined to Wipe Out Whole Family—Boy May Die.

KANSAS CITY, MO., October 27.—Robert M. Snyder, a millionaire of this city, under indictment in St. Louis on a charge of bribery, was killed tonight in an automobile accident at Independence Boulevard and Park Avenue.

Snyder, in his own automobile, which was driven by Frank M. Schneider, an expert chauffeur, who came recently from Cleveland, Ohio, had just passed a moving trolley car when the chauffeur saw a small boy jump from a bicycle directly into the path of the automobile.

Not Regain Consciousness.

Snyder was taken to the Andrew Hospital nearby, but died in a few minutes without regaining consciousness.

Snyder was taken to a police station and later released, but it was noted that he was not driving faster than ten miles an hour.

Hand of Death Upon Them.

A new indictment against Snyder was returned last month, charging that the necessary witnesses were again brought within the jurisdiction of the court.

Robert A. Snyder was the father of Peter M. Snyder, who, while a fugitive from justice, was murdered near Hillsdale, N. J., several months ago.
