

STEWARDS ARE TOO EASY ON THE EASTERN TRACKS

Indulgent Supervision of Complimentary Officials Causes Howl Among Followers of the Sport--Recent Farm Reversals Responsible.

BY J. S. A. MACDONALD. NEW YORK, July 13--Just now the public is not getting the money here in the East. Neither is the bookmaker. The race-track associations and the slick padock factions who cook up and arrange moral elches are gathering in the harvest.

Under the indulgent supervision of the complimentary stewards employed in the Jockey Club system the rankest form reversals pass unchallenged. A man may run his horse short on a Wednesday and then come out and beat a better field on the following Saturday.

Here the padock framers get the money while the public and the bookmakers lose heavily. It appears the freebooters are taking undue liberties with the easygoing stewards. The present tolerance of these sharpers is hurting racing more than all the screeching reformers in the entire State.
