THREATENS TO SUE THE CITY

Permit to Sell Milk Revoked. Dealers and Board Work in Harmony, and Latter Will Consider Request for Amended Laws.

The two bonds aggregate \$6,000,000, and one for \$4,000,000, covering the property of the Standard Oil Company of Indiana at Whiting, and the other for \$2,000,000, covering the company holdings outside of Whiting.

Stands Ready to Support Bryan if He Decides to Run.


