The football elevens of the Universities of Virginia and North Carolina will arrive in Richmond this afternoon for their annual game, which will be played at Broad Street Park at 4 P. M. to-morrow.

No comparison of the relative strength of the teams is obtainable, for the reason that they have not met the same teams this season. Carolina's eleven consists chiefly of new material, there being but four or five men of much football experience on the squad.
