To Erec Building. Among the important measures introduced yesterday was one by Senator Watkins proposing the appropriation of \$95,000 for the erection of a building in the city of Richmond in which to place the mineral and timber exhibit as displayed at the Jamestown Exposition and presented to the State by the Virginia Mineral and Timber Association.

By Mr. Goorlick--To authorize the city of Fredericksburg, Va., to issue bonds to registered bonds of the city for the purpose of erecting a public school building for said city.


By Mr. Goorlick--To authorize the City Council of Fredericksburg, Va., to give a portion of the lot in said city on which the city courthouse is located as a site for a public library building.

By Mr. Hunt--To provide the mode of ascertainment of damages in favor of abutting owners where any city or town shall cause injury to property by reason of the grading of any street, alley or other public place belonging to such city or town, and to give to any assessment so made against the city or town the effect of a judgment.

By Mr. Thrift--To amend and re-enact section 2108 of the Code of Virginia, in relation to unlawful fishing, etc., as amended by acts approved March 6, 1894, and March 14, 1905.

By Messrs. Tallaferra, Curlett, Bowman and Thrift--To amend and re-enact section 2070 of the Code of Virginia, as amended and re-enacted by an act entitled an act to amend and re-enact chapter 35 of the Code of Virginia, in relation to the preservation of certain useful birds and animals, and to prevent any unlawful hunting, etc.
