

TOTAL STAGNATION IN STOCK MARKET

Bank Statement To-Day Will Be Watched With More Than Ordinary Interest.

ACTUAL CONDITIONS SHOWN

NEW YORK, February 7.—Heaviness and almost total stagnation continued the characteristics of all departments of the securities market to-day. There was no evidence of any participation in the dealings outside the narrow professional element in the neglect of the market was the coming resumption to-morrow of the detailed bank statements for all the institutions of the individual banks which had been in advance ever since the decision to issue clearing house loan certificates at the time of the resumption. Importance is given to this condition by the beginning of weekly statements of the condition of all the institutions, trust companies in New York to be given out with the regular bank statement, which will commence to-morrow. To-morrow there is to be the old form of statement of clearing house banks averaged, a statement of the actual items of members, one of the average of other banks and trust companies in Greater New York and an aggregate average for all the institutions. With such a weekly exhibit coming from the clearing house there will be again opportunity for continuation of conditions in actual banking position in New York City. It is probable that some degree of final preparation for complying with the new law has entered into the week's operations and was accounted for by some closing up of loans and occasional weakness in securities which figured as collateral.
