BIG CELEBRATION OF DAY IN MANCHESTER

Flag-Raising at New High School Building was Feature of Program--Parade Largest Ever Seen in City.

Amid the roar of cannon and the strains of "The Star Spangled Banner" the Stars and Stripes were unfurled and raised upon the Manchester High School Building under the auspices of the Junior Order United American Mechanics yesterday afternoon at 2 o'clock.

The celebration eclipsed anything of its sort ever seen in Manchester before. Weather being ideal, people turned out in large number, and the bracing February breeze rippled among the national colors displayed on every side.

Parade a Feature. The ceremony, which was the distinctive feature of the observance of Washington's birthday in the South, was carried out in detail as arranged by the committee, the parade forming at Seventh and Hull Streets, from which point it moved promptly at 1 o'clock.

At that hour Hull Street was thronged with people, young and old. The column was headed by Chief Lycomb and Sergeant Wright and Officers Moore and Waymack, mounted. The order of the procession was as follows: Chief Marshall Aaron Sampson and aids.
