I immediately ordered the firing to cease, told the men the sad news, took the battle flag from the color bearer, cut it from the staff, and, with Lieutenant John Burson, of the 11th Virginia, and John D. Carr, of the Albemarle Rangers, left the field. I never surrendered and was never paroled.
