LESS BEER BEING DRUNK
Prohibition Leader Claims Great Falling Off in Quantity Used.
CHICAGO, ILL., September 26.—According to figures given out here last night by Charles R. Jones, chairman of the Prohibition party, there was an astounding decrease in the production and sale of intoxicating beverages in the United States during the months of July and August last. Nearly \$1,000,000 a day was the decrease in liquor production, as estimated by the prohibition leader.
