HANDSOME STORE FOR PETERSBURG

New Building Will Be Erected Soon Near the Chesterfield Hotel.

ROBBERY OF TWO SALOONS. Money Taken From One and Whiskey and Small Sum From the Other.

PETERSBURG, VA., October 13.—A goodly number of Petersburg Knights of Columbus went over to Richmond last night to attend the exercises incident to the dedication of the new home of the Knights of that city.

N. J. Francis has sold, to Dr. H. G. Leigh, the vacant lot on Sycamore Street, adjoining the Chesterfield Hotel, on which formerly stood J. O. James' shoe store.

The Jefferson Liquor Company's saloon, on Bank Street, was robbed last night of about \$125 in money, nothing else, so far as known, being taken.

The saloon on 10th Street, owned by Willis Gilliam, colored, was entered through a rear window last night and robbed of several bottles of liquor and a quantity of cash.

Case of John M. Peters on Trial at Gate City for Forgery. [Special to The Times-Dispatch.] GATE CITY, VA., October 13.—After one of the most hotly contested legal battles in the history of Scott county, the trial of John M. Peters on a charge of forgery, is ended. The trial began last Wednesday.

This case grew out of a civil suit in which Mr. Peters is plaintiff and W. A. Ruth defendant. Some time ago Peters sold his suit to Ruth, who removed to Illinois. Peters claimed there was a verbal contract by which Ruth was to resell him the land in case he decided to return to Virginia.

Last spring Peters returned from the West, and his suit alleged that he had purchased the land and paid Ruth \$2,200 for it, taking his receipt. Ruth denies this and charges that the receipt is a forgery.

Several witnesses testified. An expert from New York testified in favor of Ruth. Several bankers of Virginia testified, the majority declaring the signature to appear to be genuine. A number of witnesses testified as to the credibility of the respective litigants, and several facts were proven, tending to show the existence of the verbal contract. One man testified to seeing Peters pay Ruth a large roll of money.

At the close of the trial the jury returned a verdict of not guilty.

DOCTORS OF GREENSBORO IN AN INDIGNANT MOOD. Denounce Conviction of Member of Their Profession for Prescribing Whiskey for Himself Say Chief of Police Laid Trap for Another.

[Special to The Times-Dispatch.] GREENSBORO, N. C., October 13.—In the Municipal Court to-day Dr. J. C. Wadley was tried on a charge of violating the prohibition law, the offense being that he prescribed whiskey for himself. The doctor testified that he was sick and broken down from hard day and night work, was suffering with incipient jaundice and prescribed whiskey in order to obtain it from a licensed drug store, just as he would have done for any other medicine.

Prosecuting Attorney Shaw insisted that physicians could not prescribe liquor for themselves under any circumstances, and Judge Dure so held, binding the physician over to the Superior Court. Four-fifths of the physicians here were advocates of the prohibition law, but here and elsewhere uniformly prescribing whiskey for themselves when they needed it.

The physician in court to-day is a sober man of high character, as was established by witnesses before the court, as without exception the detection of constitutional rights. They declare that they never before heard of the proposition that under no circumstances could they prescribe liquor for themselves without violating the law, and that they will not submit to such a law until it has been tested in the highest courts of the country.

They are equally emphatic in their criticism of the cases yesterday, declaring that the chief of police gave a man money and sent him to a physician with a story about his sickness, in order to entrap the doctor into a violation of the law. It is impossible, they say, for a physician always to know a man is lying when relating his ailments.
