SPANISH CABINET FORCED TO RESIGN

Internal Dissensions Brought to Crisis by Execution of Professor Ferrer.

MADRID, October 21.—The Spanish Cabinet, which was formed January 25, 1907, under the premiership of Antonio Maura, resigned to-day as a result of the bitter attacks made against the government by the former premier, Maura y Pradera, representing a part of the opposition.

At a conference with King Alfonso, Premier Maura told the King that in the face of Senor Maura's statement the opposition would refuse to discuss even the most urgent measures, he had no option but to resign.

Advice received here state that a steamer which was on its way to Guatemala to get war supplies has been seized by the authorities of Honduras.

LET CITIES CHOOSE THEIR OWN METHOD

Local Option in Municipal Government Favored by Conference.

SEEK AMENDMENT TO CONSTITUTION At Meeting to Be Held in Richmond January 6 Petition to Legislature Will Be Prepared—General Sentiment That Change Is Desirable.

Norfolk Senator Will Be Named to Succeed Eggleston.

It was apparent early this morning, after conferences lasting the greater part of the night between party leaders, that Colonel W. W. Sale, of Norfolk, would be the nominee of the State Committee at its meeting to-day to succeed the late David C. Eggleston as Secretary of the Commonwealth. A decided movement was on foot during the night looking to an effort at reconciliation between the two factions of the party in the State through the nomination of a man who has been in the anti-administration wing, but decided opposition blocked this attempt, at least for the time.
