BURIAL SERVICES OF FIVE VICTIMS

Children Burned in Orphanage Fire in Lynchburg Laid to Rest.

RAISE FUNDS TO REBUILD

Citizens Quickly Subscribe \$10,000—Presbyterian Synod to Contribute \$20,000.

[Special to The Times-Dispatch.] LYNCHBURG, Va., October 28.—The funeral services of the five little girls who were cremated in the Presbyterian Orphanage fire Tuesday morning occurred this evening from Westminster Church.

Some of the children could not attend the service, being detained at the orphanage by colds contracted after escaping from the burning building. Several also have sore throats from inhaling flames.

Campaign for Subscriptions. The plan was today to raise \$10,000 to assist the Virginia Presbyterian Synod in rebuilding the orphanage on an enlarged and more improved scale met with liberal response.

MUST SHOW CONTRACT NEXT MONDAY NIGHT

Street Committee Determined to See Papers in Richmond and Henrico Case.

INQUIRY MATTER DELAYED

Kelley Explains That Some Work Was Done Prior to September 22.

Against the protests of several members of the committee who wanted to investigate the status of the Richmond and Henrico Railway franchise, especially to ascertain whether or not it had complied with the terms of its agreement as to starting work on or before September 22, the Committee on Streets last night passed a resolution laying the matter on the table, thus giving the company two more weeks of grace before an investigation is ordered.

He called attention to the fact that he had first offered a resolution for an investigation which had been voted down by the Committee on Streets.
