MADE LIQUOR IN CAROLINA HILLS

Alleged Operator of Enormous Plant Caught in Daring Raid by Revenue Men.

Revenue Agent Chapman yesterday received a report from Deputy Collector Adams, of Dunn, N. C., of a successful raid in the mountains of Johnston county, N. C., and of the arrest of H. M. Young and Tom Powers, alleged operators of an enormous plant for the illegal distillation of spirits. Commissioner M. T. Young applied the men to jail, and they will be tried before the next term of the United States District Court in Eastern Carolina.

In their efforts to make a complete round up, the revenue men were baffled by the inaccessibility of the location, and one of the operators escaped to the hills. It is seldom that the agents, especially in mountainous territories, succeed in landing the distillers, as the vicinity of the plant is carefully guarded night and day, and places of hiding are prepared. Young and Powers are alleged to have been engaged in the actual making of corn whiskey when the officers surprised them. No resistance was offered, as the collector's pistols were put at once into play.
