NEW YORK, December 24.—William R. Hearst regained control of the Independence League party organization in Manhattan and the Bronx last night, when it was reorganized. Tammany Hall, it will be remembered, by what the Tammany men called strategy and the Independence League men called theft, took the organization, its emblem and its column on the official ballot away from Hearst at the primaries last fall.

Credit for the recapture of the league organization was unanimously accorded to Charles E. Gehring, who was chairman of the New York county committee while the league was controlled by Hearst. Gehring, whose duty it was to issue the official call to last night's meeting, said in his summons:

"Incidentally, newly elected members of the county committee are urgently requested to bring with them their membership dues for the ensuing year." With four lean years ahead, the Tammany men elected members of the county committee at the primaries apparently did not relish the idea of making the disbursement required to stage a primary man answered when the roll was called.

Mr. Gehring admitted last night that if the Tammany men, who had been elected in strict compliance with the law, had shown up, the league would have been in a position to Tammanyize the county committee by electing any officers whom Tammany Leader Murphy might have instructed them to choose. Tammany Hall carried fifteen districts in the primaries; the league carried sixteen. The remaining Assembly districts there was a split, with some Tammany men and some league men elected. In the aggregate the Tammany men would have had a comfortable working majority out of the 181 members of the new committee.

Chairman Gehring had sent out calls to all the newly-elected members, including the Tammany men. He waited for a full hour after the time for which the meeting was scheduled before he called it to order; yet not a Tammany man appeared. From all the districts of the county, however, which is a quorum and a clear majority.

"This will give us back control of the party emblem and the party color, or at least will force Tammany to go into court and fight for them. I had thought that after going to court in this case, the Tammany men would have the nerve to come here and fight it out, instead of showing the white feather. I guess the orders to stay away came from Fourteenth Street."

Mr. Gehring said that the Independence League party would have a full ticket in the fight on the gubernatorial election next fall.

"And it will be a ticket that will be heard from," said Mr. Gehring. Which was taken to indicate that Mr. Hearst was back on it.
