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## NEWSPAPER MEN MARVEL AT FLYNN

### Fighter Has Undergone Great Transformation Since He Fought Johnson in 1907.

Las Vegas, N. M., July 1.—When Tommy Ryan went out word to the pugilistic world that Jim Flynn was fit that veteran of the ring knew that he was telling an untruth to vent a personal spite.

New arrivals among the war correspondents and others who made their first visit to the Flynn camp became convinced just as those who have been watching for days and weeks already had become convinced that Flynn had indeed shed his hard-earned reputation of work he stepped on the scales strapped to his browned skin and tipped the beam with the indicator at the 150-pound mark.

Those who had seen him when he once fought Johnson weighing less than 150 pounds wondered at the change. Others who had seen him when he beat Al Kaufman and Carl Morris were also pleased to note that in being new to the scene but that he carried an under look of strength along with that additional pounds. There is not a superfluous pound on him.

Because Jack Johnson did not boxing with a full house in a big arena at Montezuma, when Flynn appeared to show how he was going in his boxing career.


The work of Flynn consisted of a series of boxing lessons in training. He started in with a ball and showed a good eye and plenty of clever footwork. From the time he started in he never paused for a moment of breathing space as he went from one exercise to another. From the handwork he sped through a light sparring session in a big arena.

The medicine ball with two sparring partners took up another session. In the ring he took exercise on the floor to strengthen his back and leg muscles, and then he made three battles with his masters on a punching bag filled with 100 pounds of oats and suspended from the rafters.

Flynn's sparring partners, like Johnson, are well worn out, but he swapped punches for two full rounds with Ray Massey, a Kansas City middleweight, and then kept busy for three more full rounds with Big Al Williams, a man of Jack Johnson's size. And after it was over he suggested his sparring partners that he was certain to be the next champion of the world.

Flynn has improved, is quicker, biter harder, and shows more of the trained boxer and fighter than ever before. He certainly has a chance to win if the negro champion has gone back to his old good chance.

**GOLD MEDAL FOR ROSTRON.**  
House Passes Senate Bill Conveying Thanks to Carpathia's Captain.  
Washington, July 1.—The thanks of Congress are conveyed to Captain Arthur H. Rostron and the officers and crew of the liner Carpathia for their rescue of 711 survivors of the Titanic in a Senate bill passed by the House today. The measure now goes to President Taft for signature. In addition, the bill provides for a \$1,000 gold medal for Captain Rostron, which, in the language of the bill, "shall express the high estimation in which Congress holds the service of this officer, to whose promptness and vigilance was due the rescue of 374 women and children and 330 men."
