

# TRAINING SCHOOL BEGINS TOMORROW

Mass-Meeting of Sunday School Workers Will Be Held in St. Paul's Episcopal Church.

MANY NOTED TEACHERS HERE

Faculty Will Consist of Instructors Identified With General Religious Education Board.

Opening with a mass-meeting tomorrow night at St. Paul's Church, a training school for Sunday school workers will be conducted for four days, under the auspices of the Episcopal Sunday School Institute of the Richmond Diocese. The initial session will be held in the main auditorium of the church, but the other meetings will be held in the Sunday school room. There will be three sessions daily, the school closing with a stereopticon lecture on Friday night.

**Three Daily Sessions.** On Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, at 4 o'clock, Mrs. Edna Phelps Hastings, a successful author and teacher in primary grades from Washington, D. C., will speak and conduct model classes in primary work from 5 to 6 of the same days. Mrs. John Loman, a noted teacher of junior workers in the Diocese of Pennsylvania, will explain "How to Teach the

Church Catechism in Diagram, Picture and Story." At 8 o'clock on the same nights, addresses will be made by Rev. E. J. Dennen, a prominent specialist in Sunday school work, and will be followed by Dr. Mitman. The session will close on Friday night with a stereopticon lecture by Dr. Mitman on "Ephesus, Athens and Corinth, Three Cities Visited by St. Paul."

**Distinguished Teachers.** The faculty consists of the following: Rev. S. U. Mitman, Ph. D., South Bethlehem, Pa., Sunday school field secretary of the Third Province; Rev. Lester Bradner, Ph. D., New York City, director of teachers training of the General Board of Religious Education.

Church, Lynn, Mass. Dr. Mitman is field secretary of the Third Province, which includes twelve dioceses in the States of Pennsylvania, Delaware, Maryland, Virginia, West Virginia and the District of Columbia, with a population of nearly 12,000,000. There are 12,000 scholars and 12,000 officers and teachers in the province, all of whom come under his supervision. Dr. Mitman is a man of wide experience and has studied the Sunday school problem from every viewpoint.

Dr. Bradner has been identified with the teacher training plans of the joint commission on Sunday schools and the General Board of Religious Education for nine years. He is in touch with the whole movement for the betterment of Sunday school instruction and with religious education in general and is well qualified to conduct this branch of the institute.

**Member of General Board.** Mr. Dennen has been a member of the General Board of Religious Education for three years, and his course on the "Scientific Management of the Sunday School" has been adopted by the teacher training committee as one of the correspondence courses especially intended for superintendents and

rectors. It will be published shortly by the board. Mr. Dennen has one of the most successful parishes from an educational point of view in the North. Mrs. Loman is the president of the Primary and Junior Workers' Union of the Diocese of Pennsylvania and is field secretary of the elementary Sunday school work in the same diocese. She has been a member of the faculty of the summer school at Bethlehem, Pa., for several years and lectured at one of the New Jersey summer schools. The lessons for the primary department now appearing in the Sunday School Magazine are prepared by her.

Mrs. Hastings specializes in primary instruction. She was formerly a public school teacher and has taught Sunday school classes for fourteen years. For the past eight years she has prepared the primary lessons and graded the primary department. She will conduct classes for primary and junior teachers, and will explain to them the general plan and purpose of her outlines of illustrated lessons.
