NEGRO SNATCHES PURSE
Mrs. Grace B. Sawtelle, of East Eleventh Street, was the victim of a purse-snatcher on Wednesday night at 6:30 o'clock when a negro grabbed her pocketbook while she was walking along Decatur Street, between Fourth and Eleventh Streets. She had just returned from the Northside. She had only 15 cents.
"Well, the thief was fooled this time," she told Captain A. S. Wright, who was standing on the corner. She said that she offered no resistance to the negro, but willfully relinquished her purse. She said she was walking down the street, she said, after paying a bill at S. T. Covington's, when a heavy-set negro leaped out from behind the corner, making a spring for her pocketbook. Captain Wright immediately gave pursuit, but valuable time had been lost while Mrs. Sawtelle was telling her story, and he was unable to catch the thief. The police have a fairly good description of him.
The robbery occurred in almost the same spot in which Mrs. Edward McCarty, of West Fourteenth Street, had her purse containing \$7.50 snatched by a negro, Albert Scott, colored, was arrested as the thief, but was dismissed for lack of evidence.

SEAL OF APPROVAL GIVEN
Administration Stands Behind Secretary's Seal.
Washington, December 25.—The administration has set the seal of its approval upon the general principle of settlement by arbitration of all questions that may arise between the United States and a general arbitration treaty between America and Denmark. This convention has so far proved to be a success. It has been reduced to the form of a tentative treaty drafted by Secretary Bryan, and now before the Danish Foreign Office awaiting its approval of certain amendments, which already have been agreed in principle by the Danish government.
