KING PETER QUILTS THRONE OF SERBIA

Report That He Has Formally Abdicated Throne for Bath. Leaves Belgrade for Bath. Belgrade, June 24.—King Peter I. of Serbia was reported to-day to have abdicated the throne in favor of his second son, Prince Alexander. The King left Belgrade in the afternoon for the baths at Vrnja. In the southern part of Serbia, and a note issued by the official agency, in announcing the King's departure, did not say he had abdicated, but confined itself to the statement that His Majesty had signed a ukase entrusting the government of Serbia during his absence from the capital to Crown Prince Alexander.

MURDER GAVE HIM THRONE

King Peter I. who is seventy years old, ascended the Serbian throne June 15, 1902, after the murder of King Milan, of Serbia, but for forty-five years he himself never set foot on Serbian soil until he had been elected King by the Serbian Parliament. Prince Alexander was born on December 4, 1888. He has hitherto been in Switzerland and there went to the French military academy at St. Cyr. He participated in the Franco-German War as an officer.

ORGANIZATION WINS IN DANVILLE FIGHT

Elects Its Delegates and Indorses United States Senators and Representatives in Congress. (Special to The Times-Dispatch.) Danville, Va., June 24.—A meeting, which was largely attended by the Democrats of this city, was held to-night at the courthouse to elect delegates to the Fifth District convention. From the beginning it was seen very clearly that there was a test of strength between the machine and anti-machine factions for the control of the delegates, both sides being upon the controversy in regard to the selection of a postmaster.

COMMISSION IN BRISTOL

Bristol, Va., June 24.—Members of the Tax Commission of the Virginia legislature, Edward Echols, chairman, spent to-day in Bristol, and were guests of Bristol business men in a favorable tour. The commission has just concluded a sitting at Big Stone Gap, where the mining interests were considered. FIND COUNTERFEIT \$10 BILLS.

Secret Service Men Make Seizure in New York Following Arrests. Washington, June 24.—Four hundred and twenty-five counterfeit \$10 buffalo notes were seized by secret service agents in New York to-day. The notes were found in a vault, the key to which was given to W. J. Flynn, chief of the secret service, by one of the accused. Candy stores were victimized in passing the bad bills. High-grade confectionery was purchased and the change pocketed. As the counterfeit bills were fairly good, they escaped detection until submitted to expert inspection.
