Be it ordained, That all Public Hacks shell stand be the west of the Artesian Well, on the middle of the Main street, and all drivers of such Hacks shell at no time to distant more than five feet from it.

Every Public Cart. Dray, or Wagon hirs, shall be marked with the initials of the owners, name, the number of the license, and the letter H, for hirs; and every Private Cart, Dray, or Wagon, shall be marked as above, having the letter P, for private, which shall be painted white on a black ground, oneome conspicuous part on the side of the Hack, Dray, or Wagon.

That the driver or owner of any such Hack, or vehicle, riolating any of the sections of this Ordinance, shall incur and be liable to a fine of three dollars for every offence, one-ball which shall go to the inform r.

The above Ordinance will be rigidly enforced from this date.
