FIND BODY OF W. W. DUNCAN. Minot, Jan. 12 - After a two day search over the whole county the dead body of W. W. Duncan, former business man of Minot, was found in an outhouse in Riverside Park about nine o'clock this morning.

FIND BODY OF W. W. DUNCAN. It is believed that the man had taken some poison and ended his life, a suicide, probably in a mentally unbalanced condition.

FIND BODY OF W. W. DUNCAN. The body was found lying in an outhouse with the door locked on the inside, indications pointing to the belief that he had been dead for at least 24 hours.

FIND BODY OF W. W. DUNCAN. Every nook and corner in the city and surrounding country was thoroughly searched following his disappearance from his home Thursday noon.

FIND BODY OF W. W. DUNCAN. While Mr. Doe is very reticent concerning the facts of the matter, it is understood that the death came about through drinking carbonic acid.
