Grand Forks, N. D., Aug. 19.—Stellweg, Jayne and Burr, Minneapolis players, competing in the open singles in the North Dakota Tennis tournament today, reached the semi-finals stage. Tomorrow Burr and Jayne will meet, while Stellweg will play the winner of the Clark and Knight game in the fourth round.

Both are Minneapolis players, so that city will, during next year have possession of the Trafford Jayne trophy, a \$500 loving cup, and will hold the Red River Valley championship.

In the North Dakota singles, Sunday, Minneapolis' Blatherwick, Muir and Crawford have reached the semi-finals and those games will be played off Friday. In the state doubles, Wilkerson and Davies play Sundberg and Blatherwick in the semi-finals, while Woollege and Crawford meet Hoffman and Pollard.

In the open doubles, Jayne and Stellweg will meet Barnes and Sundberg, all Minneapolis players, and play in the semi-finals tomorrow. Enright and Fishback, South Dakota players, meet Knight and Burr of Minneapolis in the same stage of that event.
