BISMARCK WINS OVER JAMESTOWN

First Invasion of Enemy's Bowling Forces Repulsed by Locals Under Cap. Mahoney.

A whirlwind finish in the tenth frame of the first game, when every member of the Bismarck contingent scored a strike and thereby came into an extra whirl at the ten pins, combined to give them a margin of 129 pins for a start, over the Jamestown representative bowling team, which invaded the Capital City alleys for the first inter-city series of the season. Before the dust of battle had cleared away, Capt. Mahoney's forces had more than held this advantage, the final reckoning showing them winners over Jimtown by a total of 131. The visitors managed to total 2,329 pins in the three games, while Bismarck scored 2,457 in the aggregate. Edwards of the local squad drew high individual score, with 216 in the initial contest, while McLaughlin held a high average for the three games with a fraction of over 185 to his credit. His high score was 204, and his consistent work had much to do with Bismarck's victory.

Bismarck will return the compliments with a match game at Jamestown next Saturday night. While in the city the visitors were feted at Howan's Cafe de Luxe, by Jack Mezrow, manager of the local alleys. AGGIES LOSE TO SOUTHERN A. C.

Watertown, S. D., Nov. 15.—Fighting gamely every minute, but handicapped by the loss of some of its best players, who were injured in the game a week ago, the football team of the North Dakota Agricultural college was defeated here Saturday afternoon by the South Dakota State college eleven. The score was 1 to 6. Football fans for 50 miles around, including 200 rooters and a band from the South Dakota college, crowded the sidelines. North Dakota played a good defensive game, and in the first quarter held the South Dakota players from scoring, keeping the ball in South Dakota's territory part of the time. In the second quarter they weakened, and Skinner made a touchdown through tackle for South Dakota. North Dakota kicked off in the second half, and Skinner made a sensational run of 80 yards for a touchdown. Game made the third touchdown for South Dakota in the fourth quarter. Stevens made the three goal kicks.

TALK DOBIE FOR YOST'S JOB

Gilmore Dobie, former coach for the North Dakota Aggies, is being talked of in some quarters as a possible successor of Yost, as coach of the University of Michigan football.

The story, of course, is interesting, particularly to North Dakotans, because of Dobie's success in handling the state aggies during his connection with that aggregation, but no loyal Michigan football fan has the slightest idea that Dobie will be named.

Of course, it has been a bad season for Michigan, but they all have had seasons, and Michigan football supporters so far do not seem to have arisen in wrath over the record. Yost's work in years gone by is still too fresh in the memory of the Michigan men to permit the harboring of thoughts by them—or at least the bulk of them—of football at Ann Arbor without him.

MURDERER HELD AT WHITE EARTH

Minot, Nov. 15.—Fred Buchanan, who shot and killed an unknown man on Great Northern train No. 4 yesterday morning at White Earth, was arrested at Williston late yesterday evening and brought back to Stanley, where he is being held on a charge of first-degree murder.

A number of people who saw the shooting, including Levi Gittroy of this city, were able to identify him as the man who did the shooting.

He gives his name as Fred Buchanan and says his home is at Jacksonville, Fla. There is no question about his identification.

The officials of Mountrail county have not been able as yet to identify the man who was killed. The body is being held and the officers will secure the help of some Minot people
