

MEDORA NOTES A CHANGE IN TIMES

Medora, N. D., Dec. 28.—Twenty-five years ago there was a Christmas dance at Medora. At that time Medora had the only hall, for dancing, between Dickinson and Glendive. The little towns, or stations, as they were then called, between the points mentioned were small, and during the long and lonely winters amusements were few. When a dance was announced to be given at Medora people came from as far west as Wibaux and from as far east as Dickinson. Few, indeed, were the people who lived in the country off the line of the railroad. One hundred and eighty persons attended the ball of 1890, when the best supper ever served here at a dance was furnished by Mrs. Oren Kendley, nee Minnie Whitney. This Christmas the crowd was not so large as 25 years ago, and of all of those who attended in 1890, only one was present at the ball this year. How times and conditions have changed, and with the times, the people. In the year 1886 Medora had about 500 residents; of which only three remain today.
