# THE MARKETS

## "WAR BRIDES" LEAD ON STOCK MARKET

Crucible Steel Rises to 93; Bethlehem and General Motors Is Up.

New York, Sept. 13.—Trading was again extremely active and broad today. The total sales amounted to \$1,280,000 shares, making the seventh consecutive session in which the dealings have run into seven figures. U. S. Steel and the Motors and Rails furnished a large percentage of the output. The movement in rails and other investments was the most noteworthy of recent weeks, but was overshadowed in the final hours by a general demand for "war brides" especially crucible steel, which rose to 93. Further advances were registered by some of the highest priced specialties. Bethlehem Steel gave 30 3/4 points at 555. General Motors added 55 points to yesterday's gain of 52, the stock going to 697. This establishes a new record for any issue in the United States Stock exchange, aside from the Northern Pacific, which sold at \$1,000 a share in the memorable "corner" of 1901. Gross gains of almost six points were scored by Maxwell and Studenbaker, with more moderate advances in accessories, except Kelly-Springfield Tire which was distinctly weak. Mexicans, Sugar and Leather issues helped to swell the rising tide, but Marines and other recent favorites, including the Paper group, again were susceptible to profit taking at one to four points recessions.
