THE MARKETS CEREALS SHOW A BIG BULGE NEW RECORD MADE IN STOCK MARKET

Price of Wheat Soars Due to Aggressive Buying; Oats Also Has Good Day

Chicago, Sept. 22.—Aggressive buying of wheat resulted today from unfavorable crop conditions in Argentine and from export transactions that aggregated 1,500,000 bushels.

Except just at the close, wheat prices were on the upgrade virtually throughout the session. A scarcity of offering was evident right at the outset.

Further returns in values came about from assertions that mills in the Dakotas were shutting down owing to difficulty of obtaining supplies.

Unfavorable crop reports from Ohio did a good deal to lift the corn market. Wheat strength was also a bullish factor.
