Lodg ard was arrested about two weeks ago. He was prominently engaged in the liquor business at East Grand Forks, prior to his removal to Moorhead several years ago.

**BIRDZELL INVITED "UNI" OFFICIALS TO FIRE HIM**  
Luther E. Birdzell, professor of law at the University of North Dakota, supreme court justice-elect, twice invited University of North Dakota officials to "fire" him from his post.

That F. L. Crawford, president of the state board of regents, as well as president Frank L. McVey, each invited Mr. Birdzell to retire from the law school faculty, when he became a nominee for the supreme court justice job, has just come to light. Messrs. Crawford and McVey took the view that retirement was in order because of politics.

But, to each, Mr. Birdzell gave denial—and in turn invited the officials to discharge him if they cared to do so—but in the meantime, he intended to continue on the job.

Since his election to the supreme court, Mr. Birdzell has resigned from the college law faculty, the same effective with the close of the fall term of school.
