WARM WEATHER IS GOVERNMENT FORECAST

Low Pressure Reported in Canadian Northwest—Means Fair and Higher Temperature

Government weather officials announced this morning that a high pressure and moderately low temperature prevailed this morning over the northern part of the country. Light scattered snowfall has occurred in the upper Missouri valley.

In the Canadian northwest, he reports that there is a low pressure accompanied by fair weather and higher temperature. Indications are that the southward movement of this low pressure will result in fair weather in North Dakota tonight and tomorrow with higher temperature tonight in the north and the west portions, and in the east portions Wednesday.
