

NORTHERN LEAGUE MAY TAKE OVER TERRITORY OF WESTERN CANADA

Re-Organization Will Be Considered at League Meeting To Be Held on Monday

Fargo, N. D., Dec. 2.—Reorganization of the Northern league on a basis that will bring Winnipeg, Moosejaw and Brandon, Canada, and Minot, Grand Forks and Fargo into the circuit will be considered at the league meeting to be held in Minneapolis Monday.

John Moll of Winnipeg and Secretary Farrell of the national commission have both submitted this scheme to other league directors.

It would mark the finish of the finish of the Western Canadian league, the Northern league taking over that territory.

Duluth and Superior would be abandoned.



Here's Play That Gave Uncle Sam's Cadets Victory Over Middies One Week Ago Today



This picture, the first of the Army-Navy gridiron struggle, taken Saturday at the polo grounds, New York, shows the play that gave the Army victory over the Navy! It shows Elmer Oliphant, the greatest individual scoring machine of the 1910 season, kicking a placement Oliphant, almost single-handed, won the game for Uncle Sam's future generals. On the kickoff, at the very start of the game, he caught ball on his own five-yard line and raced 90 yards to Navy's five-yard line before being downed by the fleet-footed Ingram. Then, on two terrific bucks, Oliphant carried the ball over for a touchdown. It was only a few minutes later that he kicked the field goal that gave Army a total of nine points and decided the game which ended 15 to 7. The picture shows the course of the ball and the pigskin as it sailed directly between the goal posts.


