EFFECT OF TOBACCO STUDIED
Physician Asserts That Cigarette Smoking Causes Rise in Beats of the Pulse.

Cigarette smoking often causes a marked rise in pulse beats, makes the pulse irregular and causes a change in blood pressure, the effects being more marked if the smoke is inhaled, is the conclusion of Dr. James Altkman of New York, the latest authority to endeavor to determine the exact effects on the human race of cigarette smoking.

Doctor Altkman's experiments are no more productive of definite conclusions than those of many other investigators of the past, remarks a writer in London Tit-Bits. He suggests, however, that the great increase in circulatory diseases in the past hundred years may be attributed to smoking, although admitting that in the face of conflicting opinions "we can see how


