WHERE WE ASK INDEMNITY.
The cave man was too ignorant to think it up, and so he beat out his rival's brains with stone or club.
The Tartars got an inkling of it, when they impaled their captives for hours of agony that death alone relieved.
The heathen Chinese came within touch of it, when they broke their prisoners' limbs, joint and pulled out their fingernails and tongues.
The Romans, in all their wars with barbarians of all sorts, never encountered it as a national or tribal method of warfare.
The American savage, fond of torture and ingenious in prolonging it, did not resort to it.
It remained for cultured Germany of the twentieth century to introduce the destruction of the eyesight of men as a method of winning in war.
Through the centuries of study, research, culture, development and uplift, through the list of names of great Germans who contributed to progress in industry, arts and science, the focus burns upon this damned spot, this idea from hell; and from the shame, horror and brutality Germany may not recover.
We want you to read Newland's story about Roland Park Hospital, near Baltimore, where the government is trying to "reconstruct" our blind soldiers, blinded by HUN war gas, because we're going to get a radical suggestion.
These blind soldier boys must be utterly reclaimed and so these "reconstructing" him first go to work on his mental readjustment.
When you are between the ages of 21 and 30, a decided mental change takes place upon a German putting out your eyes.
Formerly, you could go about as other men, independently, without fear, conscious of your strength to look out for yourself. Made sightless by a German, you must guide your feet with a cane; a little dog may be useful to lead you; you must tremble at noise of street car, auto or wagon; you may smell the fire that you cannot locate; you must always depend on someone else something for even the common things; you must give up the flowers, the mountains, the green fields, the glistening, rippling brooks; you must merely imagine all new faces, all new people, all new things.
Formerly, you looked into your young wife's eyes and saw a gleam from heaven that thrilled you. Or, you took your baby upon your knee to make it laugh, or to glow over its growth, the way its curls were beginning to twine about its neck, the struggles it made to say "Daddy," to realize that it's part of you and maybe will grow up just like you.
No more of that—forever! To crush and rule millions of men like you, the German has gassed you into blindness, everlasting blackness, an opaque curtain between you and all that you loved.
Wisely the governors of Roland Park Hospital decide that such a change has an effect on the mind. Mental readjustment is necessary. Yes, today, to see wife or babe's beloved face, to be in and of the bright world. Today, to see nothing; to be in a world between life and death!
One of these blind soldier boys of ours—OURS!—writes Newland, has been so mentally readjusted that he joyously sits down and pens a letter to his mother, in wobbly characters, perhaps, but legible. May God alone be with that mother when she reads it.
"You should see them at football, following the course of the ball by hearing. You should see how they carry on like joyful kids while doing it," says Newland. No! We don't want to see that while there's a living HUN who has not felt all the punishment that's in the strong arm of America. We American boys, blinded by HUNS, follow the ball don't want to stand on the side lines and watch by hearing. We want to be in the trench lines removing HUNS.
Well, government is going to "reconstruct" these blind boys, so far as possible. It's going to teach them vocations to make independent, so far as possible. It is finally going to turn them out into the world to get along, as well as possible. IT IS NOT ENOUGH! It is not enough for our blinded boys. It is not enough for the cowardly brutes who blinded them.
When he came to sit at the peace table, he

should demand at least \$10,000 indemnity for the blindness of every American victim of the HUN war practice of Germany. And now isn't too early to notify the unforgiving HUN autocrats that such is our intention.
Hungary clings more closely to the HUN than Hungary.
A recent news story was headed "Our German Guests Behind Barbed Wire."
Our German guests!—at Fort Ogletrope and Fort McPherson.
These disciples of despotism make gardens and toys, a few work in a quarry but are PAID for it—and after an eight-hour day, tennis, volleyball and reading is provided for their delectation and amusement.
Prisoners of war—a submarine crew and HUNS from raiders, the kind that sink hospital ships and fire on the life-boats—PAID for the work they do.
And the officers have special quarters with exemption from labor. Heaven help us!
In Brandenburg, they poison the water to kill off the prisoners. The sentries kick, beat, lash and smash them with thong and rifle butt. The prison doctors hasten the death of the ill.
The HUNS in our detention pens, our "internment hostels" are the same as those guards at Brandenburg. And we PAY them to work for us!
