

The county commissioners of many counties are already buying grasshopper poison. According to Stewart Lockwood, grasshopper expert of the North Dakota agricultural college, the indications are that there will be a pretty good crop of grasshoppers this year and the best time to get them is early while the hoppers are still small. They are easier killed than when allowed to reach some size. By buying grasshopper poison now there is time to look around and find out where it can be secured the cheapest and also to have it shipped in the cheapest way. Several counties last year that started action late found that they had to take whatever poison they could get and then they had to have it shipped by express. This was particularly true in counties that did not have a county agent. Several of them spent enough extra on the grasshopper poison to have engaged an agent for several years.
