

#### The Red Flag.

The red banner and the red flag have been the emblem of labor and revolution for more than 2000 years. In the ancient world the favorite colors of the aristocracy were white and scarlet blue, while red was plebeian. 

#### SEWED HER SPINAL CORD.

Neuro Operation Performed on a Wounded Girl.

While Miss Nichols was leaving Thompson's Spa in Philadelphia the other evening, where she and a young man named Holmes were employed, the latter drew a revolver and fired two shots at the young woman, after which he shot himself through the heart.

The second bullet passed through the spine, and directly against the spinal column. Its appearance indicated that it had struck a vertebral root and inflicted only a slight wound.

Complaints passing failed to dislodge the bullet, because it had become firmly imbedded in the rest of the spinal column. Paralysis of the entire muscular system had set in below the severed cord and a second operation was decided upon.

Dr. Francis T. Stewart, chief resident physician of the hospital, assisted by Dr. L. Marshall Van Meter and Dr. Thomas J. O'Brien, succeeded in removing the imbedded bullet and closing the severed ends of the spinal cord, which were fully three-quarters of an inch apart, sewed them together in such a manner that should the ends knit as has often been regarded as impossible, there would be a possibility of the paralytic eventually passing away and of the young woman recovering the use of the lower muscles.

Miss Nichols' wound was of such a character that at first her chances of recovery were doubtful. But since the severed ends of her spinal cord have been sewed together she is rallied considerably, and it is now thought she will survive.
