

TO RUN AGAINST ROOSEVELT.

Boom Started for Judge Parker of New York.

Washington, Jan. 22.—Still the boom grows for Judge Alton B. Parker as Democratic candidate for the presidency, to run against Roosevelt in 1904. To undermine the Republicans in New York is the plan of the Democratic managers. Get a man strong enough to defeat Roosevelt in his home state, and a long step has been taken toward victory.

The state is regarded as doubtful. Only 18,000 plurality for Odell for governor last year is worrisome to the Republican managers. It was only 18,000 plurality for Roosevelt five years ago, when the war enthusiasm was still hot. Each year the Democrats have been growing stronger and the Republicans weaker.

The state has 39 electoral votes. That would help a lot. The South, it is figured, will be "solid." The issue will be anti-trust. On this Roosevelt is strong; but there is every reason to anticipate that his party will not back him up, and any failure of congress to do so will be made the most of in the presidential campaign.

Parker is to appear also as the champion trust buster on a more radical platform. He will advocate removing the duty from all trust goods. This will fit in with the general democratic policy of tariff revision.

HOTEMA THE WITCH KILLER

Has Gone to Atlanta to Serve a Life Sentence.

Paris, Texas, Jan. 22.—Solomon Hotema, the renowned witch killer, was taken to the United States penitentiary at Atlanta, Ga., today to serve out a life sentence. Hotema's case was one of the most noted murder cases ever tried in this federal court. He was twice tried, the first time resulting in a mistrial, and the next time he was convicted of murder in the first degree and sentenced to be hung. The president commuted his sentence and Hotema leaves today to serve out the life sentence.

Much influence was brought to bear for a pardon for the old Indian, but it was refused. He entertained strong hopes of being pardoned up to the time of his being taken away, and even then he did not seem discouraged.

Hotema was a Presbyterian minister, educated and well to do. He killed several people in the Territory because he claimed they were witches and should be destroyed. On trial he pleaded insanity. He is an old man, being about sixty years of age, and has a strong, intelligent face.
