

NEW ELECTRIC LIGHT RATES.

Following are the new electric rates which will be put into effect May 1, 1903. In all cases where these rates are lower than the present rates they will apply for the present month, but where they are higher than the old rates, the old rate will prevail until May 1, 1903.

Minimum meter rate, \$1.50 per mo.
Each addition light per month 70
Flat Rate for 16 Candle Power Lamps for Residence.

1 light, per month \$1.25
2 lights, per month 2.00
3 lights, per month 2.50

Each additional light per month 40

Flat Rates for Arc Lighting.

Each 1200 candle power arc lamp:
All night per month \$13.00
Midnight per month 8.50
10 o'clock, per month 7.00

Meter Rates for Day Power Service.

(This does not include electric fans.)
Up to 25,000 watts per K. W. hr. 12
25,000 to 50,000 10
50,000 to 100,000 8
100,000 to 200,000 7
200,000 to 300,000 6
300,000 and up 5
Minimum meter rate per month \$2.00

Meter rates for arc lights, fans and Nernst lamps same as other light meter rates.

Flat rate for incandescent lamps, other than 16 candle power, to be in proportion.

Flat rates for single 9-hour Nernst lamp 1 1/2 times flat rate for 16 candle power incandescent lamp.

Flat Rate for Electric Fans.

Each 12-inch desk fan per mo. \$1.50
Each 14-inch desk fan per mo. 1.75
Each 16-inch desk fan per mo. 2.00
Each ceiling fan 2.50

In all cases of paying by meter where meter reading comes near the division point the charge will be made on the basis of the next lower rate at the minimum quantity. For example: 95,000 watts at 12c, \$11.40.

This would be charged on a basis of 100,000 watts at 10c—\$10.

There will be no midnight flat rate, as all customers will be on the 24-hour circuit, and parties desiring lamps for only a few hours each day may take meter if they do not desire to pay flat rates.

We will endeavor to have our solicitor see each of our customers personally between now and May 1, 1903, and ascertain which of the above rates you desire to select, and in case we fail to see you it will be taken for granted that you desire to continue on the flat basis or the meter basis, as the case may be, which you are now using.

There will be no discounting bills. All bills must be paid in full the same as any other bill which you pay.

Our new plant will be in operation for 12 hours about Monday, April 13, and our 24-hour service will begin in about six weeks—or sooner if we can complete the placing of our machinery.

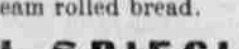
