

ARDMORE WON

DEFEATED TISHOMINGO YESTERDAY IN FIRST OF SERIES.

Came Was Desperately Fought From Start to Finish—Every Score of the Game Made During Sixth Inning—Score 5 to 3.

Before a large crowd and with ideal base ball weather, nothing but a good game could have been expected yesterday afternoon when Tishomingo and Ardmore engaged in the first of a three game series for a championship of the Chickasaw nation.

Promptly at 3:30 o'clock Umpire Gregory called the game. Ardmore taking the field. The first three Tishomingo men at the bat, Taylor, Clayton, Dougherty, were promptly struck out by Nichols.

With Bayne on third and Ragsdale on second, there was a chance for a score, but the Tishomingo boys pulled out of a hole by retiring Boyd for the third out.

Ardmore came in with that "Go or die" expression on their faces and the fans knew there would be something doing. In this inning, every Ardmore player came to the bat and Lucke came up the second time before the fireworks was over.

By a series of hits, Burke, Bayne, Stone and Ragsdale scored before any outs were made, following them Boyd and Savage made outs, then Home Run Redford caught one on the end of the bat, which Jones, Tishomingo's left fielder, was unable to swing, and Redford was on third before the ball could be returned.

The feature of the game was the excellent pitching of Nichols, who struck out fourteen men, and the almost faultless playing of the entire Ardmore team. RESOLUTIONS.

Of Recording District No. 22 as Corrected From Former Report.

Resolved, that there shall be organized in recording district No. 22, in the Indian Territory, a Democratic executive committee to be composed of a chairman to be elected by the delegates to recording district (No. 22) convention, and one person to be elected by each club already organized or that may be organized hereafter except the club from which the chairman is selected; that said club, as soon as possible, elect members for said committee and their election shall be authenticated by the president and secretary of the respective clubs electing said committeeman, and immediately forwarded to the said chairman, and the said committeeman, when so elected, as herein provided, shall constitute the executive committee of the 22nd recording district of the Indian Territory; that the time and places for meeting of said committee shall be determined by the said chairman; that said chairman must be elected by the said recording district (No. 22) convention, and should a vacancy occur between the meetings of said convention, the committee shall meet as soon as possible, and if a majority thereof is present, shall proceed to elect a chairman who shall hold office until his successor is elected by said convention as herein provided; and the said committee is empowered to pass rules and regulations with reference to the organization in said district as a majority thereof may determine, not in conflict with the rules and regulations in force or that may be put in force by the executive committee of the Indian Territory, and not in conflict with well established Democratic principles.

And be it further. Resolved, that the delegates from this convention urge at the Territory convention that similar organizations be established in every recording district in the Indian Territory.
