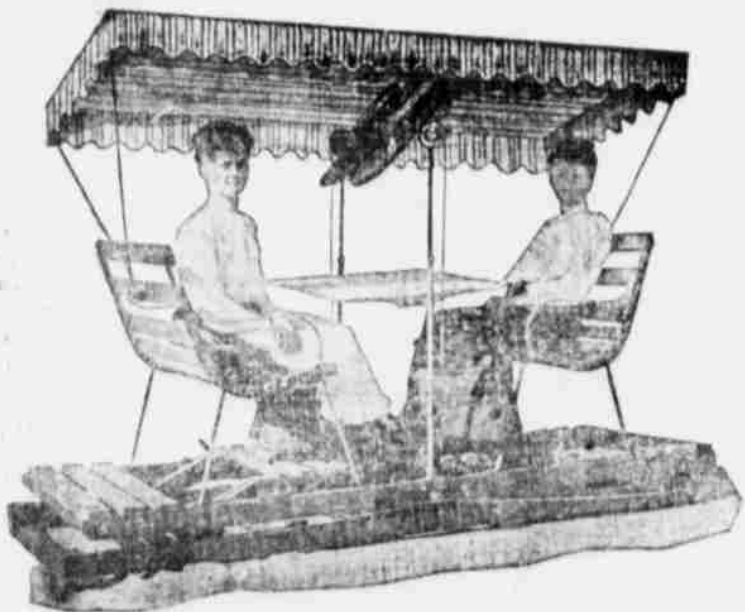

The undertaking establishment was thronged almost all day, and although several persons stated that the face on the dead man looked familiar but very few were able to tell anything of his past life.

Undertaker Robertson stated that the name of Lon Stringer was given by a few, but other names were also mentioned. Mr. Robertson was informed by one party that the dead man's name was Lon Stringer; that deceased came here from Bowie, and that his parents lived in Ada, I. T.—Fort Worth Record.
